## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Members of Employment Security Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 26, § 1081, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 1081 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 328 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:
- 2. Salaries. The chairman of the commission shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$13,000 \$17,500 per year, and each of the other members shall receive a fixed weekly salary, at the rate of \$12,500 \$17,000 per year, and shall be paid from the Employment Security Administration Fund.
