STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Registers of Deeds and Register of Probate in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 10th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Oxford County, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Oxford County: County commissioners, \$1,950; chairman, \$2,150; clerk of courts, \$4,500; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$3,000; sheriff, \$4,800; register of deeds, eastern district, \$4,500; western district, \$2,700 \$4,000; judge of probate, \$4,200; register of probate, \$4,200.
