IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Movement of Contractor's Equipment Over State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 1703, amended. Section 1703 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the State Police may grant a special permit covering all equipment employed upon a public highway construction project to move or operate such equipment upon any highway or bridge within a radius of 25 miles of the construction project.
