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**AN ACT Relating to Constitution of Police Department of City of Lewiston.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 1, repealed and replaced.** Section 1 of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**Sec. 1. Police department; how constituted.** The police department shall consist of a police commission of 5 members, hereinafter in this article referred to as the commission, to be appointed by the mayor. The commission shall appoint a chief of police, such superior officers and such number of patrolmen as the commission shall deem necessary, the entire personnel of which, as existing when this charter takes effect, shall continue subject to the provisions hereinafter contained.

**Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, §§ 11, 18, repealed.** Sections 11 and 18 of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 are repealed.
