RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Vanceboro for Aid Extended William Gardner.

Town of Vanceboro; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,107.06 to be paid to the Town of Vanceboro to reimburse the town for support of William Gardner.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve would enable the Town of Vanceboro to settle a claim by the City of Portland for hospital bills incurred by William Gardner. Gardner has not lived in Vanceboro since 1960 and the town is responsible only through a technicality in the law.

Vanceboro, a small town of about 300 inhabitants, has a declining population and economy with no industry. To bear this claim would be a great hardship on the already overburdened taxpayers of Vanceboro.
