# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Additional Staff Within Eye Care and Special Services Division, Department of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Eye Care and Special Services Division; additional staff.** In order to utilize funds made available by the Federal Government for its vocational rehabilitation program, the Division of Eye Care and Special Services, Department of Health and Welfare, is authorized to increase its staff as follows:

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Rehabilitation caseloads are far in excess of the number that counselors can adequately provide needed service to. Recent increases in the amount of federal money available to match state money will enable the division to increase staff by 3 people without additional expenditure of state money. Failure to improve services over the present level will result in a decreased rate of federal matching.
