AN ACT Providing for Salary Increases for Certain Classified State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 592, sub-§ 2, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection 2 of section 592 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

C. Compensation plan, which plan must include the salary increases provided for in section 634-A,

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 634-A, additional. Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 634-A, to read as follows:

§ 634-A. Salary increases

The director shall forthwith submit to the board a proposed revision of the official schedule of salaries for all classes of positions in the classified service which shall provide that any employee being compensated in accordance with a pay range and whose hourly rate of pay is \$2.04 or less shall forthwith be advanced to pay range number 8, step D. All classified service employees whose hourly rates exceed \$2.04 but who are in pay range 6 or pay range 7 shall forthwith be advanced to that step in pay range 8 which calls for an hourly rate equal to that they are now receiving.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$775,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to effectuate a minimum of \$80 per week for all state employees.
