**AN ACT** Relating to a Student Tour of the Maine State Prison under the Supervision of the Commissioner of Education.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 20, § 102, sub-§ 16, additional.** Section 102 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 16, to read as follows :

**16. Student tour of Maine State Prison.** To arrange for and to supervise a tour of the Maine State Prison by all male students in the 9th grade or freshman year in high school in all school systems, both public and private.
