SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 934, L. D. 1350, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Unity Institute."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the period
at the end and inserting in place thereof the following: 'and
John F. Kennedy Institute.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line (same in L.D. 1350) the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec.1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
section:

'Sec. 2. John F. Kennedy Institute designated John F.
Kennedy College. Notwithstanding the Revised Statutes, Title 20,
section 2203, John F. Kennedy Institute in Fort Kent shall hence-
forth be designated John F. Kennedy College and shall be eligible
for state and federal surplus property. It shall be eligible for
aid under any Maine Higher Education Loan Authority Act,
notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in said Act.'
