COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 459, L.D. 1359, Bill,
"An Act Requiring Approval of County Commissioners of
Court Term Bills."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line (7th and 8th lines
in L.D. 1359) by striking out the stricken out words "~~and the
Supreme-Judicial-or-Superior-Court~~" and inserting in place
thereof the following words 'and the Supreme Judicial or
Superior Court'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the
following underlined sentence:

'No term of Superior Court shall adjourn until the presiding
justice shall certify to the county treasurer that all expenses
incurred during such term have been submitted for payment.'
