STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Clerical Assistance for Clerks of the Law Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 54, amended. Section 54 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 392 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

Each clerk of the law court shall be reimbursed by the State for charges actually and reasonably incurred by him for clerical assistance, but such reimbursement by the State shall not exceed the sum of \$3,000 in any one year.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Supreme and Superior Judicial Courts the sum of \$2,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
