STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of New Sharon for Support of Angie Thompson.

Appropriation; Town of New Sharon. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$552.75 to be paid to the Town of New Sharon to reimburse the town for support and medical care furnished Angie Thompson.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the summer of 1964, Mrs. Thompson suffered a broken shoulder from a fall at the home of her employer. Her injuries made it necessary for her to be confined to Hales Nursing Home through that summer and most of the following winter. She was without funds, thus making application to the town for relief. After considerable investigation it was determined that she did not have settlement anywhere in Maine whereupon an application was made to the Department of Health and Welfare on March 24, 1965.

The total claim came to \$956 of which the State reimbursed the Town of New Sharon for \$403.60. This leaves a total of \$552.75 for reimbursement to the Town of New Sharon.
