RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Part of Moose River, Somerset County.

Resolves, 1963, c. 31, amended. Resolved: That chapter 31 of the resolves of 1963 is amended to read as follows:

Fishing on part of Moose River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations establishing on Moose River from Brassua Lake to Moosehead Lake in Rockwood Strip and Taunton, Raynham Grant, Ti Ri, Somerset County, the opening date for fishing as May 1st of each year, open under the general laws from May 1st to September 15th of each year elosing to all but fly fishing with a daily limit of one fish from September 16th to September 30th of each year.
