COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 951, L.D. 1382, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Care of Paupers at Jefferson Mens Camp."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following Title: 'An Act Relating to
Care of Indigent Adult Males at Jefferson Mens Camp.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last
underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

Jefferson Mens Camp, when facilities are available, may be
utilized for the care and support of indigent adult males and
other dependent males having a settlement within a municipality
of the State. The Department of Health and Welfare may make
arrangements for the care and support of such persons with
municipal officers of a municipality or with county officials,
provided that the municipality or county shall be responsible
for payment of expenses of the person at the Jefferson Mens Camp.
