STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Care of Paupers at Jefferson Mens Camp.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4468, amended. Section 4468 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Jefferson Mens Camp, when facilities are available, may be utilized for the care and support of paupers and other dependent persons having a settlement within a municipality of Knox, Lincoln or Sagadahoc Counties. The Department of Health and Welfare may make arrangements for the care and support of such persons with municipal officers of a municipality within said counties or with county officials of said counties, provided that the municipality or county shall be responsible for payment of expenses of the person at the Jefferson Mens Camp.
