SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 953, L. D. 1384, Bill, "An
Act to Relieve Elderly Persons from Increases in the Property Tax."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line (same in L. D. 1384) the underlined abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§658." by
inserting after the underline subsection 8, the following underlined
subsection:

'9. Claims by municipality. Any municipality granting
exemptions under this section shall have a valid claim against
the State to recover the taxes lost by reason of such exemptions,
upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory to the Commissioner
of Finance and Administration.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following section:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending
June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act.'
