AN ACT Relating to Enactment of Municipal Zoning.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 4953, sub-§ 3, repealed and replaced. Subsection 3 of section 4953 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

3. **Enactment; public hearing.** For a municipality to adopt zoning, it shall first hold a public hearing before its planning board. At least 10 days thereafter its legislative body, at a regular or special meeting thereof, shall vote pursuant to chapter 207, whether or not said municipality has previously adopted said method of voting, on the following question: "Shall the municipal officers be authorized to enact and amend a zoning ordinance?" If said question is voted on favorably, said municipal officers may enact and amend from time to time a zoning ordinance. Any ordinance enacted under repealed section 4953, subsection 3 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes of 1964, remains effective and may be amended according to this section.
