IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Provide for Night Pay Differentials for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for night pay differentials for state employees. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$118,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$142,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, for the purpose of placing into effect, as of the first pay period after the effective date of this Act, a one-step increase under provisions of the State Personnel Board's Compensation Plan for Classified Positions, such step pay increase for those who, for the year or any part thereof, are regularly employed on night shifts.

Said pay differential shall be applied at the direction of the State Personnel Board with the right to appeal by the employee or his representative.

The same provisions and standards shall be applied to those employees who are employed by departments which are supported wholly, or in part, by the General Highway Fund, special revenue funds or other funds.
