AN ACT Repealing Exemptions Under Itinerant Vendor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4502, repealed. Section 4502 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

§ 4502. Exemptions

~~This chapter shall not apply to sales made to dealers by commercial travelers or selling agents in the usual course of business, nor to bona fide sales of goods, wares and merchandise by sample for future delivery made by those who sell goods, wares and merchandise at retail from a car, wagon or other conveyance, steamer or vessel, nor to hawkers or peddlers on the streets or peddlers from vehicles.~~
