STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Elinor Nichols of Poland for Well Damage by Deposit of Salt on Highway.

Elinor Nichols; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,800 to be paid to Elinor Nichols of Poland as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to her domestic water supply caused by the depositing of salt on her premises.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sand and salts were used on the highway near Mrs. Nichols' property, located between Mechanic Falls and Auburn, and contaminated her water supplies and plumbing.
