**RESOLVE to Reimburse Richard Jewell of Mechanic Falls for Well Damage
by Deposit of Salt on Highway**

Richard Jewell; reimbursed for well damage. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,400 to be paid to Richard Jewell of Mechanic Falls as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his water supply caused by the depositing of salt on his premises.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sand and salts were used on the Pigeon Hill Road near Mr. Jewell's property and contaminated his water supplies.
