**RESOLVE to Reimburse Henry T. Parent of Mechanic Falls for Well Damage
by Deposit of Salt on Highway.**

Henry T. Parent; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,800 to be paid to Henry T. Parent of Mechanic Falls as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his domestic water supply caused by the depositing of salt on his premises.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sand and salts were used on the highway near Mr. Parent's property, located between Welchville and 5 Corners, and contaminated his water supplies.
