STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE to Reimburse James Harkins of Poland for Well Damage by Deposit of Salt on Highway.

James Harkins; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,800 to be paid to James Harkins of Poland as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his domestic water supply caused by the depositing of salt on his premises.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sand and salts were used on the highway near Mr. Harkins' property located between Poland Corner and Harris Hill and contaminated his water supplies.
