AN ACT Relating to Readiness Test for School Entrance Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 859, amended. Section 859 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Superintending school committees may determine through readiness tests that a child shall be admitted to a childhood education program prior to grade one at an age lower than that otherwise established in this section.
