AN ACT Transferring Responsibility of Educating Indian Children to Department of Indian Affairs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 1452, amended. Section 1452 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 450 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

The Department of Indian Affairs shall be responsible for educating the children on Indian reservations under this section.

Sec. 2. Transfer of funds. All funds appropriated by the 103rd Legislature to the Department of Education for the education of Indians for the fiscal years 1967-1968 and 1968-1969 shall be transferred to the Department of Indian Affairs for the same purposes.
