COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 979, L.D. 1421, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Computation of Secondary School Tuition."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning after the
enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, §1291, amended. The first sentence
of the 2nd paragraph of section 1291 of Title 20 of the Revised
Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 371 of the public laws
of 1965, is repealed and the following inserted in place thereof:

In the case of any youth attending school, under conditions as
provided for in the preceding paragraph and the school offers at
least 2 occupational courses, the annual tuition shall not exceed
the average cost per pupil in all secondary schools of the State
which offer 2 or more occupational courses. In schools not
offering at least 2 occupational courses, the tuition shall not
exceed the average cost per pupil in all secondary schools of
the State of that type.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line (same in L.D. 1421) the underlined abbreviation and
figure 'Sec. 2.'
