STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fixing the Number of Personnel at the State Colleges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2301-A, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2301-A, to read as follows:

§ 2301-A. Number of personnel

The state colleges are authorized to employ such faculty, administration and staff personnel as the State Board of Education shall determine to be necessary for satisfactory operation of the state colleges and for which adequate funds are available.
