AN ACT to Clarify Certain Election Law Procedures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 171, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 171 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2. — **List current.** He shall keep the list current at all times by adding the names of new voters and by removing the names of those who have died, moved from the municipality more than 3 months previously ~~with an apparent intention of abandoning their residence therein~~ or become disqualified to vote.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 1253, sub-§ 2, amended. The last sentence of subsection 2 of section 1253 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8 of chapter 451 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

The clerk shall write in ink ~~or by typewriter~~ the name of the person for whom the absentee ballot is intended in the upper left hand section of all return envelopes.
