AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Inspection of Nursing Homes, Boarding Homes and Related Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Inspection of nursing homes, boarding homes and children's homes; funds for. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund the sum of \$17,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$22,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for additional staff to inspect nursing homes, boarding homes and related institutions. The breakdown of expenditure shall be as follows:
