COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 560, L. D. 1432, Bill, "An Act Relating to Leave of Absence for Teachers Serving in the Legislature."

Amend said Bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined period at the end (same in L. D. 1432) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation: ' ,provided that written notice of intent to become a candidate for the Legislature is given at the time teacher contracts are issued. '
