**AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of Certain County Officials in Androscoggin
County**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 58 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Androscoggin County: County commissioners, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,800; chairman, ~~\$3,000~~ \$3,200; clerk of courts, ~~\$8,000~~ \$8,400; county attorney, \$6,500; first assistant county attorney, \$4,500; second assistant county attorney, \$3,500; county treasurer, ~~\$4,700~~ \$5,500; sheriff, ~~\$5,900~~ \$6,700; register of deeds, ~~\$6,200~~ \$6,600; judge of probate, ~~\$5,400~~ \$5,800; register of probate, ~~\$5,200~~ \$5,600.
