IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of Certain County Officials in Androscoggin County

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 58 of chapter 513 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Androscoggin County: County commissioners, \$2,400 \$2,800; chalrman, \$3,000 \$3,200; clerk of courts, \$8,000 \$8,400; county attorney, \$6,500; first assistant county attorney, \$4,500; second assistant county attorney, \$3,500; county treasurer, \$4,700 \$5,500; sheriff, \$5,900 \$6,700; register of deeds, \$6,200 \$6,600; judge of probate, \$5,400 \$5,800; register of probate, \$5,200 \$5,600.
