HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 542, L.D. 1443,
Bill, "An Act Relating to Highway Advertising Control."

Amend said Amendment in that part designated "§2765."
by striking out in subsection 2 all of paragraph E, and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'E. Advertising signs located in an unzoned commercial or industrial area. Unzoned commercial and industrial area means area not zoned which lies within a radius of 1,000 feet of any commercial or industrial activity, or which lies within a radius of 1,000 feet of any 2 such unzoned areas. An activity for purposes of this definition shall include all land, buildings, other structures or ancillary uses such as, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, driveways, parking lots, storage areas and landscaped areas which constitute an integral part of such activity.'
