HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 543, L.D. 1444, Bill, "An Act to
Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4, a new section,
as follows:

'Sec. 4-A. R. S., T. 5, §2302, amended. Section 2302 of
Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end,
a new paragraph, as follows:

The Hearing Commission shall suspend the liquor license for
not less than 3 months of any liquor licensee who violates Title 28,
section 1058.'
