HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 543, L.D. 1444, Bill, "An Act to
Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 33. P. & S.L. 1967, c. 66, amended. The first
paragraph of the Referendum of chapter 66 of the Private and Special
Laws of 1967 is amended to read as follows:

This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of
the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission
to the legal voters of the Town of Kittery at any special town
election to be held on or before the ~~first~~ 16th day of October,
1967, and warrants shall be issued for such election in the manner
now provided by law for the holding of municipal elections, notifying
and warning the qualified voters of said town to meet in said
town, there to cast their ballots on the approval or rejection of
this Act.

Sec. 34. Effective date. Section 33 shall become effective
91 days after the adjournment of the Legislature.'
