STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Pertaining to Payment of Overtime for Certain Employees of the State Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Overtime payment for certain State Highway Commission employees. The State Personnel Board is authorized to pay certain employees of the State Highway Commission time and a half for time worked in excess of 45 hours in any one payroll period, work week, in the following classes: Highway Maintenance Man I, II, IIa, III and IV and Automotive Mechanic, Automotive Electrician and Carpenter. Payment at this rate to be effective for the first pay period in July 1967.
