AN ACT In Favor of Highway Construction in the Town of Windsor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Highway construction in the Town of Windsor. There is allocated from the General Highway Fund to the Town of Windsor, Kennebec County, the sum of \$60,000 to rebuild a portion of Route 105, State Aid No. 1, for about 1.45 miles in length starting from the Somerville town line and extending westerly.
