**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Improvements at Indian Reservation
at Indian Island.**

Appropriation; for improvements at Indian Reservation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to the Department of Indian Affairs to provide improvements in homes located at the Indian Reservation at Indian Island, Penobscot County.
