COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1004, L.D. 1471, Bill, "An Act
Establishing a Consumers' Council."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that
part designated "§1361" (same in L.D. 1471) and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'§1361. Membership

There is created a Consumers' Council, hereinafter in
this chapter called the "council", consisting of 8 members to
be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the
Council, for terms concurrent with that of the Governor, no more
than 4 of whom shall be members of the same major political
party. The chairman of the council shall be designated by the
Governor. Said members shall serve without compensation, but
shall receive their expenses necessarily incurred in the performance
of their duties. The council shall meet monthly and at other times
at the call of the chairman.'
