AN ACT Relating to the Financing of the State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 56, amended. The 2d sentence of section 56 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The commission is authorized to keep and have on hand a stock of wines and spirits for sale, the value of which, ~~computed on less carload price quotations F.O.B. warehouse filed by liquor and wine vendors~~ **based upon actual cost for which payment may be due**, shall not at any time exceed the amount of working capital authorized.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 151, amended. Section 151 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end thereof, the following sentence:

The State Liquor Commission may lease any property no longer deemed necessary for the conduct of its business.
