STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing Free Use of Maine Turnpike for Members of Legislature During Legislative Sessions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, § 15-A, additional. Chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941 is amended by adding a new section 15-A, to read as follows:

Sec. 15-A. Use of turnpike by Legislators. The Maine Turnpike Authority shall issue free of charge a specially designed sticker for one designated motor vehicle owned or controlled by a member of the Legislature which shall be for passage of such vehicle over the Maine Turnpike while the Legislature is in regular or special session.
