## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing Monetary Compensation for Accrued Sick Leave for Classified Service Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 592, sub-§ 2, ¶ L, amended. Paragraph L of subsection 2 of section 592 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
  - L. Leave of absence, resignation, hours of service, vacation and sick leave, which sick leave rules or regulations must include the monetary compensation provision set forth in section 639,
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 639, additional. Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 639, to read as follows:
- § 639. Compensation for accrued sick leave

The director shall forthwith submit to the board a proposal that upon termination of employment in the classified service for any reason, an employee shall be paid money compensation, in accordance with the salary then being received by him under the official schedule of salaries for all classes of positions in the classified service, for all unused standard sick leave then accrued to him.
