SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1074,
L. D. 1504, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Oil Burner Men's Law."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 3
of that part designated "Sec. 2." and inserting in place thereof
the following:

3. Plants. The maintenance and operation of oil burner
installations in or about industrial or manufacturing plants,
or electrical generating plants or ether-plants any buildings owned
or maintained by them or by facilities operated by a public
utility;'
