HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1074, L.D. 1504, Bill, "An Act to
Revise the Oil Burner Men's Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last sentence of subsection 3 of that part designated "§2301." of section 1 (same in L.D. 1504) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'He shall present to the board satisfactory evidence that he has one year of practical experience, except that a journeyman oil burner man who has a valid license on the effective date of this Act may exchange his license for a master's license upon payment of the fee of \$25.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the semicolon of that part designated subsection "3." of section 2 (same in L.D. 1504) the following underlined words:

'or by an industrial or manufacturing plant'
