HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1037, L.D. 1506, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Excise Tax on Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'C. Motor vehicles. For the privilege of operating a
motor vehicle upon the public ways, each motor vehicle, other
than a stock race car, to be so operated shall be subject to
such excise tax as follows: A sum equal to 23 24 mills on each
dollar of the maker's list price for the first or current year
of model, ~~16-1/2~~ 17 1/2 mills for the 2nd year, ~~12-1/2~~ 13 1/2
mills for the 3rd year, 9 10 mills for the 4th year, ~~5-1/2~~ 6 1/2
mills for the 5th year and 3 4 mills for the 6th and succeeding
years. The minimum tax for a motor vehicle other than bicycle
with motor attached shall be \$5 \$10, for bicycle with motor
attached, \$2.50. The excise tax on a stock race car shall be
\$5. The maximum tax on and after the 7th year of model for a
passenger vehicle, including a so-called station wagon, but not
a bus, shall be ~~\$15~~ \$30.'
