#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Age of Persons Liable for Poll Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1381, amended. The first sentence of section 1381 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A poll tax of \$3 shall be assessed upon every male resident of the State between the ages of 21 and <del>70</del> 65 years, whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the place where he resides on the first day of each April, unless he is exempted therefrom by this Title.
