STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Pensions for Members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1927, c. 75, § § 1, 1-B, 2, repealed and replaced. Sections 1, 1-B and 2 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1927, as amended, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- Sec. 1. Retirement. The City of Portland is authorized to provide by ordinance for the retirement upon such pensions and at such ages as shall from time to time be established in such ordinance of members of its police and fire departments who are not members of the Maine State Retirement System and who have been honorably discharged from said departments by reason of having become disabled either in the performance of duty or otherwise or having reached such voluntary or compulsory retirement age as shall be established in said ordinance.
