HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1050, L.D. 1522, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Pensions for Widows of Former Governors."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'An Act Providing
for Retirement Allowance for Widows of Governors.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R.S., T. 5, §1121, sub-§10, additional. Section 1121 of
Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by
adding a new subsection 10, to read as follows:

10. Widows of Governors. The widow of a Governor or former
Governor of the State whose annual income from all other sources
does not exceed \$5,000 shall become entitled to a retirement
allowance at the rate of \$2,000 annually, regardless of age, for
the remainder of her lifetime. Said retirement allowance shall
become effective on the date that the board of trustees receives
written application, supported by a statement of income, from such
widow. Such adjustments as are granted under section 1128 shall be
applied to these payments.'
