IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for Pensions for Widows of Former Governors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, § 6, additional. Title 2 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 6 to read as follows:

§ 6. Pensions for widows

Upon written application by the widow of a former Governor of the State of Maine, such widow shall receive a pension at the rate of \$5,000 per year.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$19,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
