HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1076, L.D. 1539, Bill, "An Act
to Revise the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
paragraph of that part designated "§1255." of section 17 (same
in L.D. 1539) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In order to be valid, an absentee ballot must be delivered
to the Clerk before 3 p.m. on election day.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3
underlined lines of section 21 and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'The clerk shall accept all absentee ballots delivered to him
before 3 p.m. on election day.'
